Enhanced hygiene and cleaning procedures for all facilities, including the use of bleach-based leaners, disposable silverware & food service, and recommended sanitizing products. We are paying particular attention to touch points such as door handles, counters, chairs, & hard surfaces.



Policies that promote hygiene and health for our employees & staff, including instructing those who feel ill to stay home and consult their healthcare providers. We are reminding everyone to be vigilant about frequent hand washing and material handling safety.
